Each piece of selected hardwood is steam bent and constructed from the unique patented process using the original stainless steel molds. Cast bronze and carbon steel Solid™ snare drums are also available.

Lugs have the original patented, springless design and a built in lug lock for accurate and consistent tuning. The Precision Profile™ snare bed is machined with computer automation creating one of the best and most sensitive snare beds available today. Matching wood reinforcement hoops ensure stable construction and the Solid™ snare drum sound that customers remember and have come to expect from D'Amico Drums.

The throw off is machined from lightweight aluminum with a unique design available as a single or double sided configuration.

D'Amico Drums Solid™ snare drums continue to be noted for their exceptional sound and craftsmanship. The sound and style of the original drum continues to be a favorite with drummers of all styles. From Jim Bogios with Counting Crows, to Matt Van der Ende, performing live on Broadway with Wicked, the Solid™ snare drum performs.
